



2007 Learn to Skate

The program is open for all children ages four through eleven from the Tri Town area with little to no skating experience. The program runs for 8 weeks, starting on Saturday, October 6th at the Haverhill Valley Forum rink from 1:50 – 2:50 p.m. Directions can be found at <http://www.valleyrinks.com/content.php?sect=5>.

The following are a couple of reminders.

1. All children must wear a helmet at all times on the ice. Bike, ski or skating helmets are OK.
2. Check for proper fitting skates: Skate sizes run about 1 full size smaller than your child's shoe size.
3. Make certain that your child's skates are properly sharpened. Sharp edges turn better.
4. Make sure skates are tied properly. Skates too tight hurt. Loose skates can cause injury.
5. A good pair of gloves are a must (waterproof if possible).
6. Knee and Elbow pads are encouraged.
7. Hockey pants or ski pants are strongly recommended. The ice is hard.
